

Malignant Thymoma; Educational Case with Review of Literature

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Abstract

Malignant thymomas are rare epithelial neoplasms of the anterior superior mediastinum that are typically invasive in nature. They have a high risk of relapse that may ultimately lead to death. They represent about 20-30% of all mediastinal tumors and 50% of anterior mediastinal masses.

Here we describe a 45-year old Sudanese female diagnosed with locally advanced malignant thymoma, treated with chemotherapy and radiotherapy
